**Q: WHAT IS CAMP QUALITY?**

**A:** A non-profit, volunteer organization providing a FREE week-long, overnight camping experience and year-round support programs for children, ages 4-18 years of age and vary in stages of their cancer treatment or remission.

**Q: WHAT DOES A COMPANION DO?**

**A:** Each companion will be assigned to one camper. A companion spends the entire week by his/her camper's side. You will be responsible for his or her well being and care 24 hours a day, because they are never to be left alone. You are their friend, cheerleader and mentor. You will help them in their chosen activities (crafts, horseback riding, etc...) and at meal times.

**Q: WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?**

**A:**

*Complete an application form (available in January)	*Pass a police check
*Provide three written reference forms	*Complete a face-to-face interview
*Complete the volunteer training to be held June 10, 2007 for Fenton camp or 6/23 for Petoskey camp.	*Accept the obligations of Camp Quality

No healthcare experience is required, as trained medical staff will be on hand.

**Q: WHY SHOULD I SIGN UP?**

**A:** This is a great opportunity to provide support for a child. The children you will be caring for during the week will be away from their normal support systems and will need you in order to participate and enjoy the experience. You will be trusted with someone's dearest treasure—their child. The opportunity to make a difference in the life of a child should never be taken lightly. By committing a little time, you can bring a great deal of joy to a child with cancer.

**Q: HOW DO I GET INVOLVED?**

**A:** Contact us today to let us know you're interested! Spots will be filled by the early responders. If we don't have enough companions, we will have to turn children away.
